This leaves us with an unusual

For our children and grandchildren, it's a wonderful coincidence because they don't have to feel deprived of the December celebratory activities and of the presents that arrive at the homes of our Christian neighbors. However, for those of us who try to look past the usual glitter and sparkle of the season, we can also take away from it the shared promise of both faiths. At this time of the season, the nights are longest and the days are shortest. Christians light their Christmas trees to spread light and joy, and Jews kindle their Menorahs placing them near the windows to demonstrate the miracle of Hanukah. To put it simply, a small people oppressed by a tyrant could ultimately seize victory and illuminate the world with the light of peace and promise. Again, something that the Christian world understands as part of their tradition, a miraculous birth of their savior at a time when the world sorely needed brightness

This year, to further celebrate this coincidence, our congregation is inviting all of our members to a special program on the afternoon of December 25th.
